The Manhasset Union Free School (“District”) received your 37th Freedom of Information Law (“FOIL”) request for records on Monday, January 29, 2024. The FOIL request sought:

“... the evaluation data and results for each student considered for sixth grade advanced math placement in 2022 and 2021. More specifically, for each student with name redacted) provide QN COGAT %tile score, secure exam score, points given in rubric for secure exam, Renzulli-Hartman teacher rating score, rubric rating score assigned for teacher rating, work sample score, school (Munsey or Shelter), teacher (name redacted), gender, race, and whether the student was admitted/denied. If any one piece of data is missing, please provide all other data.”

Your FOIL request must be denied on the grounds that such records are protected by the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (“FERPA”) as education records. The District does not already have the requested data in a redacted form. FOIL does not require the District to redact education records protected by FERPA so your request must be denied. Finally, your request for records pertaining to student race data must be denied on the grounds that no such records exist.

Please be advised that you have 30 days from receipt of this letter to appeal to:
